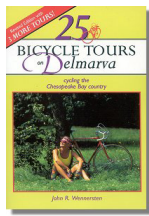

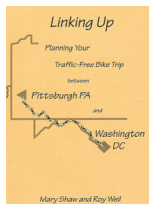


25 Bicycle Tours on Del Marva

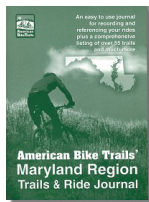

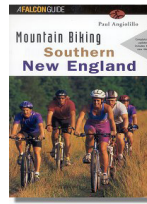

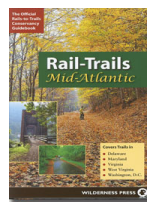
